The legal basis for the participation is the Memorandum of Understanding on participation of the Republic of Croatia in the Europe for Citizens Programme signed in Brussels on 25 September 2007 (Official Gazzette – International contracts No. 9/2007) between the European Community and the Republic of Croatia. It entered into force on 5 Movember 2007. Memorandum sets up principles, deadlines and criteria that a country has to satisfy in order to participate in the Programme. Furthermore, it sets up criteria for provision of financial and other forms of EU support intended for strengthening active participation of citizens and CSOs in the European integration process.
